Your responses are crucial for both the School and the Board of Trustees as it will allow them to include key areas in the Strategic Planning for the School over the next 5 years. Once the cut off date for the return of surveys is reached (Friday 20 August) the survey information will be read, analysed and put into a summary report on the findings listed that will be published. Please be aware that when filling in the questions in the survey that you are keeping your mind on the need to provide effective learning environments in the School that improve learning outcomes for your child / children. Remember if you do not have enough space in the comments section that you attach additional sheets as we want to hear what you have to say. The Community Survey is sent out to all parents every 2 years so it is even more important that you take time to have a say rather than waiting another 2 years. Remember to take the surveys completed to the School Office and place them in the box labelled Community Surveys. Thank you for taking the time to have your say. We look forward to your responses.
