A WORD FROM OUR PRINCIPAL...

Dear Parents and Caregivers

A very warm welcome to our new families who have recently joined us. What a wonderful start we have had to Term 4. There is a real buzz across the school with all of the learning that has been happening both in and out of the classrooms. We are very much looking forward to the School production of the Lion King next Friday, 01 November at 6.00pm. From what I have seen so far it is going to be an amazing show and is a credit to all involved.

It is this time of year that we look back and reflect so we can look forward - *Titiro whakamuri, kia whai whakaaro whakamua kia taea ai e tatou te titiro whakamua*. The Whenuapai team are currently working through a process to help inform our 2020 journey.

Carli, Karl and I have been interviewing wonderful teachers for 2020. It has been heartening to meet so many vibrant, enthusiastic young people hoping to join our team. We are now in a position to finalise the class organisation for next year and begin class placements. We will start the year with 18 classes across the year groups and anticipate opening additional junior classes during the year. The team compositions will remain the same but with an additional class at both Year 4 and Year 5/6. We have had a significant number of enrolments this term which is wonderful for the school.

At the end of the year we will be saying farewell to Janae Gaskell who is off on her OE, Jess Powell who is returning to Blenheim and Bri Winter who is off to Takapuna Normal Intermediate. We wish them well for their journeys ahead.

The Ministry of Education has signed off the additional monies for our refurbishment. This is great news for us and it means that by the end of Term 1 2020 our classes and toilet blocks will all be refurbished. Next week work begins on the toilets adjacent to Rooms 13 and 14. We are looking at having approximately \$1.2 million spent on our school to improve the learning environments for our children.

Thank you to everyone who is and continues to vote for our school in The Trusts Million Dollar Mission. Yesterday the playground committee met and are excited that a new junior playground could actually be installed sooner than we had initially thought. The team have been comparing designs and looking at value for the investment as well as installed and flat pack options. Once we know the outcome of the Million Dollar Mission the playground committee will better positioned to share design options and a proposed timeline. We continue to have dialogue with key playground suppliers to ensure we get the best outcome for the monies raised. We are very grateful for the on-going support from you all, as well as your extended families and friends.

On behalf of the Board, Michael Farac our Board Chair, has continued to have dialogue with members of our community who have contacted him following the School Hui last term in regard to Maori representation at a governance level. Michael invites contact from any other interested members of our community who may be interested in fulfilling this role. If you would like to discuss this further or wish to put your name forward in this capacity, please contact Michael at wsbot@whenuapai.school.nz.

The School would also like to hear from anybody who has the time, knowledge and skills to take on the role, in a voluntary capacity, to apply for local and national grants. We acknowledge that applying for grants is a time consuming process so would be very grateful to anybody who could take this role on.
