### A WORD FROM OUR PRINCIPAL...

Tēnā Koutou,

On some days it feels like the term is flying by, on others it feels like we are moving forward in slow motion. But each and every day is different and exciting - Whenuapai School is a marvelous place to be.

I would like to take this opportunity to publicly thank our amazing staff. During these challenging times they have gone over and above the call of duty to try and provide a safe, motivating and engaging learning environment and opportunities for our tamariki. On numerous occasions, I have witnessed staff members placing the needs of the child in their care above their own. The Whenuapai community is lucky to have such a dedicated group of individuals.

In our last newsletter, I introduced our Learner Capabilities. This week I thought it was timely to explore Respect for Others. Students who uphold this value will:

- Be respectful of the thoughts and opinions of others Actively, listen to new ideas
- Work collaboratively with others
- Share ideas to problem solve and work together •

**COVID-19 Update** We have received a couple of requests asking us to name the specific classrooms which contain the positive cases, so I thought I would try and explain my reasoning for sharing only the Year levels. There are two main reasons:

One - as we have divided the school into breaktime bubbles, your children are associating with tamariki from across their Year group from multiple classes. We are trying to provide the children with as much normality as possible, so we are encouraging play. Including:

- In the sandpit
- Running

• Be kind to others

Value diversity

- On the playgrounds •
- Climbing trees
- And so much more

All of these activities involve the children being close together without masks (masks are not required outside) for a period of time.

Two - early in our planning we realised that our staffing could be compromised by COVID. To remain open, as a last resort, we planned to split classes when we were no longer able to find relief teachers. This meant children would be spending whole days in other classes with children from their Year level.

These are our reasons for reporting new cases each week in Year levels because we want all parents to remain vigilant for symptoms as there is a high possibility your child has been together, at some point during the week, with other children from beyond their classroom but within their Year level.

In the last week, there have been 12 positive cases across the school. Cases have been spread across all Year levels.

Like many families in our community COVID has managed to make its way into my home. Caroline (my partner), who is also a teacher, tested positive on Friday afternoon so we are all in isolation.

The school is in good hands! I know that Molly and the team will do a fantastic job of keeping things moving in the right direction. If you need to contact Molly, please email her at mfletcher@whenuapai.school.nz.


I am so impressed at how much the students already know and how they have used mahi tahi (teamwork) to get our māra ready to be planted out.


#### Richie McCaw
