Dear Whenuapai School Community & Whanau,

Whenuapai School is full of wonderful students who are supported by the most wonderful staff, leadership team and our Principal Adam Cels.

Over the last five years our school roll has grown from 260 students to over 500 students and that number will continue to grow.

Our students are achieving in the classroom.

Despite a couple of tough years with the pandemic, there is great energy and a really positive vibe around the school.

In September this year, an election will be held providing you with the opportunity to choose the parent representatives to sit on the School Board for the following three year period.

The board's role is to oversee the governance of its school and to ensure that everything that needs to be done gets done - legally, ethically, and as well as possible in the best interests of its students.

School boards' primary objectives are determined by the Education and Training Act 2020, to ensure:

- every student at the school can reach their highest possible standard in educational achievement,
- the school is a physically and emotionally safe place for all students and staff,
- the school is inclusive of students of differing needs; and that,
- the school gives effect to Te Tiriti o Waitangi.

School board members are active leaders in their school and need to work well in a team, ask challenging questions and have effective communication skills. Boards need a balance of skills and experiences to ensure effective processes for consultation, planning, monitoring, reporting and reviewing the school performance are in place.

The current Board of Whenuapai School is comprised of five parent representatives, a staff representative and the Principal. After two electoral cycles some of the current parent representatives on the Board have indicated that they will not be standing for re-election.

For Whenuapai School to continue on its positive journey, I am reaching out to ask those of you with a passion for our school to come forward and consider standing for election to the Board of Trustees in September.

Personally, I have found the experience extremely rewarding and would recommend the opportunity to anyone that may be looking for a way to contribute positively to their school and community.

The Board of Trustees next meeting is at 6pm on Wednesday the 22nd of June in the school staffroom. The Board encourages anyone that is interested in becoming a board member at Whenuapai School to come along between 5pm and 6pm on the 22nd of June for an informal chat and tea/coffee with members of the current board. You are more than welcome to stay on and observe the meeting when it commences at 6pm.

SCHOOL HOUSE CHALLENGE



First House Challenge:

In the last newsletter, I announced the relaunch of our School House Competition. Following on from this, I am very excited to announce our first House Challenge for 2022 called 'Are you an Investigator?'.

Over the next two weeks the tamariki are going to have the opportunity to be an investigator to try and answer the following question.

Question:

What 'House Groups' does each staff member at Whenuapai School belong to? Is it Hercules, Orion, Boeing or Seasprite?

Task:

All staff members will be leaving clues about which house group they belong to.

Using these clues, the tamariki are trying to work out who belongs to their house group?

When they think they know the answers, they complete an entry form and post it in their house group box in the office. The only constraint is they cannot directly ask the staff member the name of their house.

Clues could include:

- Colours staff wear
- Clues in classroom windows
- Clues on classroom walls
- Keywords dropped in conversation
- · And many other little gems

There will be house points awarded to the house with the most correct entries.

Only one entry per student is allowed, so house teamwork is encouraged and recommended.

There will also be 5 individual prizes drawn from each House group box.

So, start sleuthing.
