Tēnā koutou,

Run, jump, throw and repeat. Athletics has been a large focus of the first couple of weeks of term. The tamariki have been awesome as they have competed in each event. Keep reading to see a full report, photos and results for the senior year group competitions.

Did you know that our Kura is growing? We currently have 525 wonderful tamariki and we are expecting 10 more before the end of this year, compared to a total of 504 tamariki in 2021. At the start of this term, we opened another new entrant class in Room 22, our last available learning space. It is fantastic that our community is expanding and each new person adds something special to our whānau.

We are experiencing a few growing pains and running out of spaces is one of them. As we look to 2023, it would be great if you could please let the office know:

1. If your child / family will be leaving Whenuapai School at the end of 2022.
2. If you have a younger child due to start school in 2023 - if you have not yet completed the online pre-enrolment form.

Staff Update - We are excited to announce that Rebecca Archer has been appointed as the new Assistant Principal (a new position) in 2023. Additionally, we have three new teachers joining us next year. We will be welcoming, Tingting Yao, Sheri Cowell and Sophia Stevens. We are excited to see what they introduce and bring to our tamariki and Kura.

School Organisation - In 2023, the Kura will be organised in a slightly different way for a couple of reasons:

1. To help facilitate the move to our new Whenuapai Senior Campus for our Year 7 and 8 tamariki and staff in Term 3, 2023.
2. To try and keep year groups and cohorts together as they move through the Kura.
3. To make the best use of the limited space we have available.

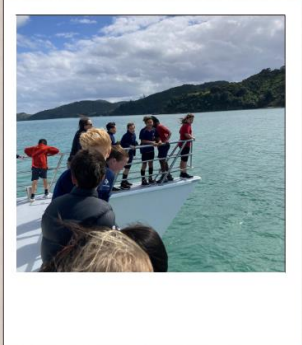
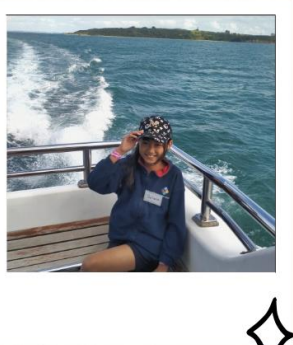

YR 8 RIVERLEA RESERVE FIELD TRIP

In week 2, some wonderful Year 8 students had a busy morning volunteering with the 'Living Whenuapai' group at our local Riverlea Reserve. This area was where the Air Force used to have a wharf to collect items that were floated down the Waitemata Harbour from the old Hobsonville Base. Sadly, once the wharf was dismantled, this popular fishing spot became a dumping ground and a haven for exotic plants and pests.

Living Whenuapai has been working hard to remove the illegally dumped rubbish, clear the weeds, eliminate the pests and plant natives to encourage the birds to come back and restore this beautiful area. Our students worked really well together to remove the weeds that had grown around some of the native plants we dug in last year right before the long lockdown. They also planted another 50 natives to aid the regeneration of the native bush and enjoyed a cup of kawakawa tea before returning back to school for lunch. Ka rawe/ awesome effort & a huge shout out to our fabulous Year 8 volunteers!

Athletics Sports Year 5/6 and 7/8

Whenuapai School held its annual Year 5 & 6 athletics day on Wednesday, 2nd of November and our Year 7 & 8 athletics day on Thursday, 3rd November 2022. The weather was fine for both events, with temperatures increasing throughout the day. Each day started with students dressed in their house colours with many shades of red, yellow, blue and green marching down to the field.

Both days started with the 1500m event, with large groups of students testing themselves over this long-distance race. Once completed, students then moved through the field events including shot put, high jump, long jump and discus and then track events which included 100m, 200m, 400m and 800m. A large number of students crossed over many events and these students competed in as many running, jumping and throwing events as they were able. Some students attempted a new event for the first time and were successful in accomplishing new personal bests. The competition for the top student in each age category was fierce and every student was attempting to improve across the day. It was evident from the final results that some students performed well in field events like throwing and jumping while other students had greater success in the running track events. Some students preferred the sprints while others enjoyed the longer distance.

Each day finished with class relays with Room 5 being the fastest overall for Year 5/6 and Room 3 Girls being the fastest overall for Year 7/8. The event was made more successful with the support of teachers, parent helpers and supporting students who coordinated events, as well as recorded placings and timing, and general organisation. The 2022 Whenuapai Athletics events were a tremendous success and the school would like to thank everyone for their support and the students for their top efforts!






After School Skate Lessons




