Kia ora e te whānau,

Firstly, this week we would like to say a HUGE congratulations to four of our amazing staff members on their teacher registration graduation. Well done to Victoria Kingi, Olivia Tustin, Elysia Paton, and Megan Powell! This is a wonderful milestone in a teacher's career, and we are very proud of them all for their commitment and dedication to their tamariki and Whenuapai School.

We are excited to share classroom organisation for 2026:

Home Campus

- Year 0 classes: Rooms 1, 2, and 11
- Year 1 classes: Rooms 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9
- Year 2 classes: Rooms 12, 13, 14, 23, and 24
- Year 3 classes: Rooms 15, 19, 20, and 21
- Year 4 classes: Rooms 16, 17, and 18

Senior Campus

- Year 5 classes: Whā, Rima, and Ono
- Year 6 classes: Tahi, Rua, and Toru
- Year 7 classes: Whitu, Tekau mā Tahi, and Tekau mā Rua
- Year 8 classes: Waru, Iwa, and Tekau

We are pleased to share some positive changes happening in Kāhu next year. As our Year 7/8 roll continues to grow, and with upcoming updates to the New Zealand Curriculum, we are now in a fantastic position to move to single year-level classes for both Year 7 and Year 8.

To support this shift, we have converted our whare hui into two additional classrooms, and we will also be restoring the senior library to its original purpose-built space (currently Tekau mā Tahi). These changes will create more focused learning environments and ensure our students have access to the spaces and resources they need.

We want to reassure you that this is a very positive step for our senior learners. Single year-level classes will allow for more targeted teaching, smoother transitions, and enhanced support for both academic and social development.

We are genuinely excited about what this will mean for our students and the opportunities it will create for their learning next year.

On Thursday 11th December, our tamariki will visit their 2026 classroom and meet their new teacher. This visit is an opportunity for students to meet their teacher, connect with their classmates, and become familiar with the environment. That same morning, families will receive an email with their child's class placement and details about the teacher. Please note we will not be sharing placement information before this date as we continue to finalise the class lists.

There is still a lot of learning and many school activities and events to enjoy before our final day on Monday 15th December. Please continue to check HERO for updates.

Finally, thank you to our wonderful community for your support and kind words as we have navigated the asbestos sand issue over the past few weeks.



PB4L CORNER



This fortnight, our PB4L focus is on Ako (Respect for Learning). As we approach the end of the school year, we are exploring what it means to continue investing our best efforts into our learning even when it feels challenging. At Whenuapai School, we know that Ako means taking ownership of our learning and respecting others' right to learn. By continuing to respect our opportunities to grow, we can finish the year feeling proud of our accomplishments and the progress we have made.

Here are some simple ways to support our Ako learning from home:





- Celebrate small achievements by noticing and praising effort as well as results. Example: "I saw you kept trying even when that maths problem was tricky - well done!" This reinforces that respecting learning means trying your best, even when it feels difficult.
- Help your child set small, achievable goals for the final weeks of term. Examples could include finishing a book, completing a project, or practising a skill for a few minutes each day. This keeps learning structured and helps tamariki achieve a sense of accomplishment.
- Model persistence by sharing examples from your own life. Example: "I'm going to finish this tricky puzzle, even though it's taking a while."

 This supports tamariki to understand the value of resilience in the face of challenges.
- Encourage self-care breaks during home learning routines to support your child's energy and motivation. Short bursts of movement, breathing exercises, or stretching can refresh the brain. Shorter, more focused learning sessions can be effective when energy is low.

Keep up the mahi - you are almost there!

New Zealand Traveller Declaration

Going overseas for the school holidays? Everyone travelling into New Zealand must complete a New Zealand Traveller Declaration, including returning New Zealand passport holders.

Its FREE and you can do it on the <u>online form</u> or on the <u>NZTD app.</u>

If you're travelling as a family or group and completing multiple declarations, the <u>NZTD app</u> allows you to copy your travel details into another declaration, making it easier to complete multiple declarations for the same journey. The submitted declarations are then all easy to see within the app.

The New Zealand Traveller Declaration collects travel, customs, immigration and biosecurity information and aims to improve the safety and security of New Zealand. It replaces the paper card you used to fill out on the plane.

To make your arrival easier, do your digital declaration before your flight back to New Zealand.
